

DNSH Criteria for Climate Change Adaptation Objective – Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing

1. Define clear system boundaries and critical interdependencies between the production unit and the ecosystem within which it operates shall be identified.
2. An assessment shall be undertaken to identify the key physical climate hazards to which the production unit and its vulnerable operations will be exposed and vulnerable over its operating life.
3. Adaptation measures shall be identified and implemented to address the material risks and shall mitigate physical climate risks to a level such that the production unit is able to manage changing climatic conditions over its operational life.
4. Adaptation measures shall not adversely affect the adaptation efforts or resilience of other people, nature, and assets.
 - 4.1. Measures shall not harm the resilience of the defined system within which the activity operates, considering the identified boundaries and critical interdependencies.
